Definition of Exempt and Non-Exempt Well

A well that is used solely for domestic purposes or for providing water for livestock, poultry or personal recreational use that is drilled, completed, or equipped so that it is incapable of producing more than 28,800 gallons (20 gpm) of groundwater per day is an exempt well. ***A well used for any other purpose is considered a non-exempt well.***

3. Attach copies of any relevant documentation or information to this application. Do not attach original documentation to this application.
4. If a portion of the information requested on this form cannot be provided, please indicate this by entering "unknown" in the related blank space.
5. If an agent is completing and submitting an application on the behalf of a landowner, the agent must attach to the application a copy of the power of attorney granting this authority.
6. If the proposed well is to be located closer than 50 feet to any property line, a completed Adjacent Landowner Waiver of Spacing Requirement form(s) must be submitted with the application.
