Drilling Permit Application for Non-Exempt Well

Complete this form if you intend to:

1. Drill a new non-exempt well;
2. Significantly alter an existing non-exempt well, or
3. Replace an existing non-exempt well.

The well owner, well operator, or any other person acting on behalf of the well owner must file a completed application for a drilling permit before a well may be drilled. (Rule 3.1.1 – Drilling Permit Requirement, District Rules, Page 17)

Definition of Exempt and Non-Exempt Well

A well that is used solely for domestic purposes or for providing water for livestock, poultry or personal recreational use that is drilled, completed, or equipped so that it is incapable of producing more than 28,800 gallons (20 gpm) of groundwater per day is an exempt well. ***A well used for any other purpose is considered a non-exempt well.***
