Well Registration Application for Grandfathered Non-Exempt Wells

Operation of a non-exempt well that existed prior to December 22, 2008 requires registration with the District and either a validation permit or an operating permit.

A well that is used solely for domestic purposes or for providing water for livestock, poultry or personal recreational use that is drilled, completed, or equipped so that it is incapable of producing more than 28,800 gallons (20 gpm) of groundwater per day is an exempt well. ***A well used for any other purpose is considered a non-exempt well.***

The District will not enter private property to complete the registration process of non-exempt wells without property owner consent.

The applicant must supply sufficient evidence of past groundwater production during a calendar year within the District's Validation Period which is January 1990 to the Date of the Original Adoption of District Rules in order to be considered for past production validation.

Note 2: If the well being registered is part of a inter-connected well system and the applicant is requesting an aggregate validation permit, past groundwater production for all wells within the system must be validated for the same Validation Year.
